Contractual protections

Confidential Disclosure Agreements (CDAs) and Master Service Agreements (MSAs) include strict confidentiality obligations

- New customer IP agreed in the MSA generated in the services is assigned to customer outright for all sites and services
- Contractual legal obligations enforceable by customer

Project team requirements

- Employment contracts and policies include confidentiality and IP obligations, which are binding on all employees, including employees of affiliates
- Confidentiality controls and obligations are covered in routine mandatory employee training
- Policies and systems limit the sharing of confidential information to those who need it in order to provide our services

Data protections

- Thermo Fisher policies and processes safeguard information by limiting electronic and physical access
- ✓ IT standards for all sites are consistent with Thermo Fisher Scientific global policy and industry standards
- All Thermo Fisher sites comply with FDA and EMEA data integrity policies and controls


